Pontão de Santa Maria is located on the south bank of Sal island, on a significant stretch of white sand beach that is an icon of the destination landscape. The pier houses artisanal fishing, tourism, nautical recreation and leisure activities, functioning as an interface between the sea and a number of hotels and restaurants, which support a significant part of the tourist activity in the city of Santa Maria. In this sense, the project will play important role in the integration and convergence of the two value chains,

transforming the existing infrastructure into an epicenter for various economic activities, namely: unloading and marketing fish, catering, tourism, water sports, among others. Based on this context, the objective of this contract will be to undertake all studies necessary for the implementation of the pier upgrade project (architecture, civil engineering, environmental and social impact assessment - including climate resilience, economic feasibility, among others).
